## **COVID-19 Vaccines Now Offered JCC South Hills**

The Jewish Community Center of Greater Pittsburgh is pleased to announce that a COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic will be held Saturday, January 15, from 9 am-noon at the JCC South Hills in partnership with American Healthcare Group, LLC and Pathways Wellness Program, for all ages, with a focus on the pediatric population.

**WHAT:** The COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic at the JCC South Hills Facility is a welcome addition to pandemic-related services hosted at JCC facilities; COVID-19 Vaccine clinics in partnership with the Squirrel Hill Health Center at the JCC Squirrel Hill also are being offered. The clinics are part of the JCC's commitment to the health of the community, and support the JCC's Vaccine Policy, which requires members and guests ages age 12 and older to provide one-time proof of COVID-19 vaccine to enter the JCC. The policy recently was updated to require members and guests ages 5-11 years old to provide one-time proof of COVID vaccine to enter the JCC, effective February 7, 2022.
