AgeWell at the JCC South Hills

Dear AgeWell Members,

We have exciting news: AgeWell at the JCC South Hills is now a Focal Point Senior Community Center site through the Allegheny County Department of Human Services Area Agency on Aging! We are excited to join the network of over 40 senior centers across the county. Our center was opened as a pilot program through the support of the Jack Buncher Foundation. While we anticipated a need for increased services in this area, we were overwhelmed with the interest and involvement you all have expressed over the last year and a half, we are looking forward to expanding our offerings to meet this need & interest. Most of the changes related to this new designation will be handled by staff in the AgeWell office, but you will notice several changes to our program taking effect over the coming weeks & months.

This new designation requires some changes in our registration process. If you've registered with us in the last 6 months, you've already completed the necessary paperwork. If you registered with us prior to February 2024, it's possible that you have not yet completed this paperwork. When it is time to update your registration, you should receive an email from the AgeWell office with more information. If you're not sure if this applies to you, feel free to stop by the office to check. This will also impact any members who live outside of Allegheny County- AgeWell staff will be reaching out to members living outside of Allegheny County with additional information.

This designation presents opportunities for new & expanded program offerings. One expansion will take place within the JCafe congregate meal program. Great news- we will be serving meals 5 days each week starting on September 3! Meals will still be offered at a suggested donation of \$3, but you will no longer be required to purchase meal passes. We hope you will continue to contribute to help offset the cost of the meals. You will still be able to register by phone, through the JCCPGH app, or in person at the JCC.

Several staffing changes will also take place within the AgeWell office. My position will be changing to Department Director, & I will be taking on more of the back-end work to make our center run. Mickey will be moving into a full-time Program Coordinator position, & they will be taking on more responsibility for running our programs & events. Our AgeWell staff from Squirrel Hill will continue to be involved in South Hills programming.

We are excited to welcome these changes as we continue to grow & expand services in South Hills. I invite you to attend one of several AgeWell Updates we have scheduled to further explore this new chapter of AgeWell at the JCC South Hills; see the details on days & times in this newsletter. These sessions will be a time to further discuss changes that will take place within our program & answer any questions you may have. We hope to see you at one of those times!
