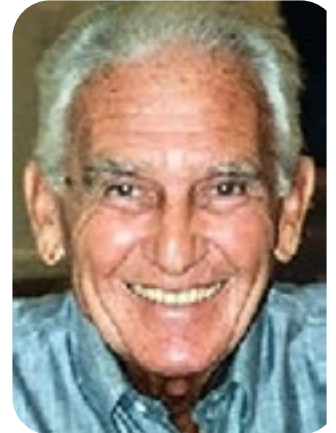

# 2025 Ziggy Kahn Awardee: Sam Clancy



Sam Clancy is in his 14th year directing the University of Pittsburgh's Varsity Letter Club (VLC). In this capacity, Clancy is responsible for athletics alumni relations, engagement and connecting "Forever Panthers" with current Pitt student-athletes.

However, Clancy's Pitt association and impact date back well before his current administrative career.

Considered one of the greatest athletes the city of Pittsburgh has ever produced, Sam "Bam" Clancy was a four-year basketball

starter for the Panthers from 1977-81, averaging 14.4 points and 11.6 rebounds per game. He is the only Pitt player to score more than 1,000 points (1,671) and grab over 1,000 rebounds (1,362) in a career.

Clancy was a three-time All-Eastern 8 selection, leading the Panthers to four winning seasons, the 1980 NIT and 1981 NCAA Tournament. He additionally played for legendary coach Bobby Knight as a member of the U.S. Gold Medal team at the 1979 Pan American Games.

His decorated basketball career earned him selection to the Pitt Athletics Hall of Fame and Pitt's All-Centennial Men's Basketball Team (1905-2006). He additionally was named an Awardee of Distinction by

the Pitt Varsity Letter Club.

Clancy was drafted by two different professional sports leagues: the NBA's Phoenix Suns (1981) and the NFL's Seattle Seahawks (1982), the latter occurring even though he never played collegiate football. Clancy played one season of professional basketball in the Continental Basketball Association (averaging 11.5 points and 8.3 rebounds for the Billings Volcanos) before playing 12 seasons of professional football.

He was a member of the Seahawks and then returned to Pittsburgh to play for the Maulers of the upstart United States Football League, earning the franchise's MVP award in its lone season of existence. Clancy later played for the USFL's Memphis Showboats

before returning to the NFL as an impact defensive end for the Cleveland Browns and Indianapolis Colts.

Clancy played for some of the Browns' greatest teams (coached by another Pitt product, the late Marty Schottenheimer), helping the franchise to four playoff berths, three AFC Central Division titles and two AFC Championship Games.

He concluded his 10-season NFL career with 227 tackles, 30 sacks and seven fumble recoveries.

Following his playing days, Clancy coached in NFL Europe, serving as the defensive line coach for the Barcelona Dragons and winning the 1997 World Bowl. He would later serve on the defensive staffs of the New Orleans Saints and the Oakland Raiders.

Clancy returned to the University of Pittsburgh in 2005 to complete a bachelor's degree in social sciences. He served as a football strength and conditioning assistant for three seasons before transitioning to the administrative side of collegiate athletics with the Pitt Varsity Letter Club.

A proud native of Pittsburgh's historic Hill District, Clancy starred at old Fifth Avenue High School, leading the basketball team

to a state championship as a junior in 1976. Following Fifth Avenue's closure, he went to Brashear High School and was a member of its first graduating class in 1977.

Clancy's legacy was honored on June 24, 2023, when the City of Pittsburgh declared it "Sam Clancy Day" and unveiled a street sign, "Sam Clancy Way," at the corner of Bedford Avenue and Roberts Street in the Hill District.

Clancy presently resides in Oakdale with his wife Terri. Between them they have five children: Sam Jr., Samantha, Samario, Evann and Samarcus. They also have 10 grandchildren.

## Keith Dambrot, Coaching



Keith Dambrot was named head men's basketball coach at Duquesne University March 28, 2017, and spent seven seasons on the sidelines guiding the Dukes.

The veteran coach wasted no time making an impact at Duquesne with 65 wins in his first four seasons, and in his final year in

2023-24 guided the Dukes to an overall record of 25-12 the 2024 Atlantic 10 Championship and their first automatic bid to the NCAA Championship since 1977.

In the 2024 NCAA Tournament, Duquesne defeated No. 6 seed BYU in the first round, 71-67, helping the Dukes claim their first win in the NCAA Championship since 1969.

In seven years on the Bluff, Dambrot compiled an overall record of 116-96 (.547), ranking fourth

in school history for coaching victories, and in 26 years as a head coach collected 529 wins and a .634 winning percentage.

Dambrot reached a significant career milestone Feb. 8, 2023, when he posted his 500th career victory, a 75-73 win over George Mason at the UPMC Cooper Fieldhouse. He concluded his career as one of 28 active Division I coaches with 500 or more wins.

More impressively, he was one of nine of the 28 who never coached at a Power 5/Big East school.

## Keith Dambrot, Coaching



Keith got his start in coaching at Akron, where he spent two years as a graduate assistant, one season as a full-time assistant before taking the head coaching job at Tiffin.

In his second season (1985-86), he led the Dragons to the most single-season wins in school history (24). In 1986, he made his first venture into the MAC, starting a three-year

run as an assistant coach at Eastern Michigan. In 1989 as head coach at Ashland where, in two years, he led the Eagles to a 48-13 overall mark, two final national rankings and the school's first-ever conference and regional championships.

In 1991, he returned to the MAC and took on his first Division I head coaching role at Central Michigan where he spent two seasons. Prior to beginning his assistant coaching tenure at Akron in 2001, Dambrot compiled a 69-10 record in three seasons as head coach

at Akron St. Vincent-St. Mary High School.

In his final two seasons, the Irish —led by freshman then sophomore LeBron James —were state champions and earned national rankings from USA Today.

Dambrot played a role in the development of James who, at the age of 13, participated in \$1 clinics Dambrot conducted at the local Jewish Community Center.

Dambrot and his wife, Donna, have two children, daughter, Alysse, and son, Robby.

## Sidney Dambrot z"l, Basketball



Sid played guard and forward at Duquesne University from 1951-1954, he was a starter on their nationally ranked basketball team. In 1954, his team was ranked #1 in the country and subsequently lost in the championship game of the NIT, which at that time, was the National

Championship.

Dambrot was a member of some strong Duquesne teams, during the 1951-52 season, the Dukes had a record of 22-4, were ranked No. 4 (AP and UPI) in the nation, and were invited to both the NIT and NCAA tournaments.

Dambrot scored 4.0 points per game in the NIT and Duquesne finished in fourth place. In the NCAA, the Dukes defeated Princeton in the East Semifinal and then lost

in the Regional Final to Illinois.

In 1953, they finished 8-7, were ranked No. 9 by AP (No. 20 UPI), and returned to the NIT, finishing third in the tournament. In 1954, the Dukes returned to the NIT on the strength of a 24-2 record and the No. 3 UPI ranking (No. 5 AP). In the tournament, Sid averaged 5.0 points per game. Duquesne defeated St. Francis, 69-63, in the first round; and beat Niagara, 66-51, in the semifinal before losing, 71-62, in the final to Holy Cross.

## Phil Elson, Sports Broadcaster



Phil's professional career started when, days after graduating from Allerdice, where he was the star catcher on the baseball team (but, just as importantly, a member of Stan

Lederman's legendary Orioles Little League and American Legion teams,) he interned for the Fayetteville, North Carolina Generals, the Single A affiliate of The Detroit Tigers. Phil, then, attended Indiana University in Bloomington, came back to Pittsburgh and graduated from Point Park University where he ran the radio station his senior year.

Phil also interned for the Akron Aeros and The Pittsburgh Pirates, then climbed into the radio booth and started his play by play career for minor league teams across America; The Ogden Utah Raptors, Helena Montana Brewers, and The Mudville Nine of Stockton California before becoming, for 14 years, the Media Relations Director and "Voice of The Arkansas

Travelers,” in Little Rock, then the Double AA affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels. Phil was also “The Radio Voice” of University of Arkansas at Little Rock (UALR) Men’s and Women’s Basketball

and Division II football powerhouse, Henderson State University.

Since then, Phil has been the “Radio Voice of Arkansas Razorback Baseball,” one of the most successful and perennially nationally ranked NCAA baseball programs, as well as broadcasting Razorback Women’s Basketball. Phil also hosts the football pre- and post-game shows

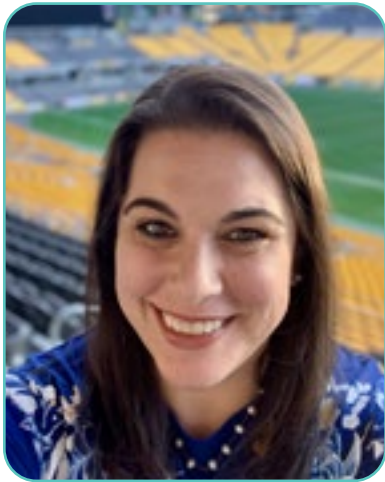
on The Razorback Network as well as his own sports talk show “Halftime with Phil Elson” on ESPN Arkansas.

Phil is a 3 time “Arkansas Sportscaster of the Year” award recipient.

His children, Sadie and Gabriel will be celebrating their B’nai Mitzvot in Little Rock in August.

## Beth Goldstein, Track and Field



Beth Goldstein, Shady Side Academy class of 1999, where she was a letter winner in basketball in 1996, 1997, 1998, and 1999; she was also a 1000+ point scorer over those 4 years.

She was a WPIAL all-conference selection for basketball in 1997, 1998, and 1999 and was the Herald Athlete of the Week in each of those years. In 1998,

she participated in the Maccabi Israel Sports Spectacular on Team USA, where she was a starter and led the team in scoring and rebounding.

She also lettered in 1997 and 1998 in track and field, throwing the shot put, and qualified for WPIAL's in the shot put in 1998. Beth played softball for Shady Side Academy and lettered in 1996 & 1997.

After Shady Side, Beth moved on to Ithaca College where she threw the hammer on the track and field team.

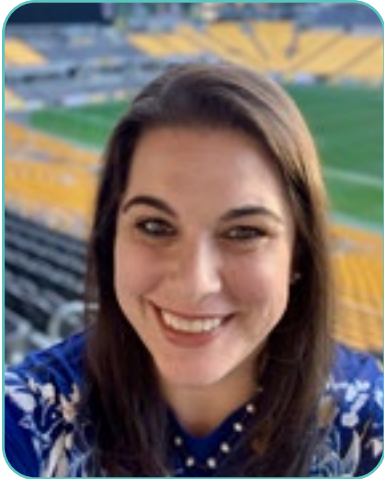
In 2003, Beth's senior year at Ithaca College, she finished 18th in the state of New York in the hammer throw with a throw of 44 meters, or 144 feet. Beth helped Ithaca College win the 2003 Outdoor Track & Field State Championship.

Other notable sports accomplishments for Beth include winning the JCC free throw shooting championship at ten years old during the 1991-1992 Harry B Davis co-ed basketball league.

She was the JCC Little League girls' MVP in 1994 and was the first girl to hit a home run

over the fence that same year. She still has the ball!

Beth participated in the AAU Steel City basketball program in 1997 and 1998. When she was at the Five Star basketball camp, she was named first-team selection in the Orange and White Classic, the all-star game played each year at this very competitive basketball camp.

Beth helped to start the women's Pittsburgh Sports League basketball league and participated in the Pittsburgh Sports League in co-ed basketball, softball, kickball, and ultimate Frisbee.

She was a finalist in the Oly Open back squat competition in the 35-39-year-old women's division, back-squatting 265 pounds and deadlifting 325 pounds.

Beth serves on several boards including One Day to Remember, Young Black Motivated Kings and Queens, Jewish Sports Hall of Fame of Western PA, and for the local

Pittsburgh chapter of Entrepreneurs' Organization. Beth and their family dog, Penny, volunteer as a therapy dog team with teens in the community.

Beth is the daughter of Linda and Bob Goldstein. Beth worked with her father at his accounting firm. After her parents' passing in February of 2020, Beth took over the firm and is now the owner of Goldstein Tax Advisors. Beth is married to Jeremy Goldman, and they have a daughter, Hannah.

## Jay Jacobs, Baseball



Jay Jacobs is a graduate of Taylor Allderdice high school where he played volleyball, basketball and baseball and was all city in baseball in 1973 his senior year. He was also in the marching band all 4 years at Dice.

Following that he went to Penn State where he played baseball. Upon graduating from Penn State Jay continued

his studies at The Ohio State University in sports administration.

After Ohio State Jay became involved in Jewish communal work where he has worked for 48 years, 25 as a CEO and he is currently the CEO at the Phoenix JCC.

Along the way Jay was a four-time JCC Maccabi Games Director, hosting the games five different times, also creating the regional games concept that is used now for the Maccabi Games.

At the Columbus JCC he was a three-time director of the Senior Olympic games. He is

also the chairman of the National Health and Physical Education Conference and has received numerous awards including the Life-Saving Action Award and is in the Easter Seals Volunteer Hall of Fame.

Outside of the JCC he is a two-time marathon finisher, has completed 11 triathlons, a three-time Boulder Outdoor Survival School participant and has completed over 50 half-marathons.

Jay is currently living in Cave Creek Arizona with his partner Olivia Pan.

## Stanley Lederman, Baseball



From the time he was a boy, Stan loved the game of baseball. That love has left an indelible mark on this community through his passion and leadership.

Stan graduated from Taylor Allderdice High School in 1965 and continued his education at the University of Pittsburgh where he ultimately earned his law degree in 1972. Stan played in the 14th Ward Little League and Pony League and after college, for the St. John's team in the Greater Pittsburgh Federation League.

In 1973, he began his involvement with the Squirrel Hill Little League, first as an umpire and a manager and ultimately as the Commissioner. For the next 16 years under his leadership, the league flourished. During that time, Stan facilitated the installation of lights, built the concession stand, and greatly improved the field conditions. He also introduced the Squirrel Hill Invitational Tournament, providing children of all skill levels with the opportunity to play and grow their skills both athletically and socially. He also managed the Pittsburgh Maccabi softball team in four regional Maccabi Games from 1986-1992. His dedication to the community's youth was so significant that upon his retirement as Commissioner in 1988, the Pittsburgh City Council honored him

by renaming the field Stan Lederman Field. His contributions were also recognized with the Ziggy Kahn Award by the Jewish Sports Hall of Fame of Western PA in 1997.

Stan's love for the game wasn't limited to the Little League. In 1982 and 1983, he played for the Pittsburgh Hardhats in the American Professional Slow Pitch Softball League, showcasing his talent on a national stage. Stan was also a player and manager for numerous upper level softball teams from 1972-1995, winning numerous league championships.

From 1992-2001, Stan was the Manager for the Greenfield American Legion Baseball team, which consisted of 16-18 year old players from the 14th Ward, Greenfield, and Hazelwood. Also in 1992, Stan raised \$25,000

to fund a weeklong trip to St. Petersburg, Florida for the Allderdice High School Baseball Team to train and compete against teams from all over the country. The trip, the first of its kind for a City High School, was a memory that would last a lifetime for the Allderdice players and coaches. In addition to the trip, enough money was raised to purchase new high quality uniforms for the team.

From 1998-2016, Stan played competitive baseball in the Northeast Ohio Roy Hobbs League, a Men's Senior Baseball League,

where Stan won titles in 2009 and 2010. Stan has also been a player and manager at the annual Roy Hobbs World Series in Fort Myers, Florida, from 1998 through today. This international tournament, held over five weeks in October and November, has seen Stan compete in age groups of 45 and over all the way up to 75 and over. During that time, he and his teams were gold medal champions eight times. He was named team MVP three times and was part of a 25-game unbeaten streak from 2011 to 2014. In addition to his achievements playing in Florida, he played in the 50 and over National Senior Baseball Tournament in Las Vegas in 2003, where his team was runner-up. He was named team MVP and made the All-Tournament team.

Outside of sports, Stan was the president of the Squirrel Hill Urban Coalition from 1980 to 1984; President of Amen Corner from 1998 through 2000; and a board member of the Hebrew Institute of Pittsburgh. He was the Allegheny County Democratic Committee 14th Ward Chair-man for three terms between 1984 and 1990, its Secretary from 1980 to 1984 and has been a Committeeman since 1978. In 2014, he was appointed by the Mayor as Chairman of the Pitts-burgh Stadium Authority, a position he still holds today.

Stan continues to practice law and has been married to Lynette for 52 years. He has two children, Moe and Kate, their spouses Kathy and Doug, and four grandchildren, Danny, Jack, Noah and Charlotte.

## Mel Solomon



Mel started his 30+ year volunteer and leadership career in the mid-1960's at the JCC's East End Branch.

As he moved through numerous facets of the agency's volunteer organization, Mel ultimately spent many years in senior lay leadership, affecting the present day JCC,

both programmatically and physically.

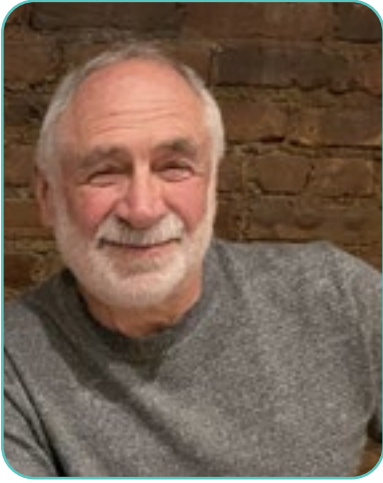
Highlights of his direct involvement include the start-up and growth of the JCC Monroeville Family Park; the purchase of the new location of Emma Kaufmann Camp, and subsequent expansion of the facility; the merging of the Y-IKC and the YM&WHA to become the JCC of Pittsburgh; construction and relocation of the JCC in Sq. Hill, the epicenter of Jewish life; and

subsequent long-term financial stability of the JCC.

While serving in these many roles, Mel was excited and humbled to be asked to join in the founding of the Jewish Sports Hall of Fame, serving as Vice President on the first JSHOF Board of Directors , co-chairing and planning the initial annual induction banquets.

Mel's community volunteer participation also led to serving on many staffing

and programming committees at the Tree of Life Synagogue throughout his two terms on the Board of Directors. During the Russian Resettlement initiative, Mel worked actively with JF&CS to secure employment for new arrivals.

Since the 10/27 tragedy at the Tree of Life, Mel has been deeply

engaged in the Tree of Life, Inc. Remember, Rebuild, Renew, project at Wilkins and Shady.

Mel is a life-long Pittsburgh resident, and a cheerleader for all that is Pittsburgh. The last 40+ years of his working career were dedicated to owning and operating Tri-Arc and Linett Manufacturing Companies retiring in 2019. Marcia and Mel, married for 60 years, continue to enjoy life to the fullest, still involved in the

Pittsburgh community. Their hearts are filled with pride as the next two generations of the Solomon family are communally immersed in Pittsburgh and beyond, with Emma Kaufmann Camp and Tree of Life at the core Linda, Jeff and Kyle, and grandchildren Ryan, Spencer, Kate, Mason and Noa are fully committed to ‘tikkun olam’ .... making the world a better place.
