Frequently Asked Questions

What are JCC Member Appreciation Days?

JCC Member Appreciation Days are 4 **WEEKDAY** dates when the Family Park pool will be open to members and JCC Day Camp families for extended hours.

The park will continue to be open to all members on weekends.

When are they?

- Thursday, June 25
- Tuesday, July 7
- Tuesday, July 21
- Thursday, August 6

What are the hours?

Pool, baby pool, changing tents	1-8 pm
Lap swimming	2-8 pm
Mini golf and tennis courts	4-8 pm
Snack bar	4-8 pm

Is there a snack bar? Can I bring my own food? Can I have food delivered?

- Yes, there is a snack bar. Kosher food is available for purchase starting at 3:30 pm. Cash and credit cards are accepted.
- Yes, outside food is permitted. Food deliveries are permitted after 4 pm. Deliveries are to be picked up by the member at cooler located at the entrance gate.

Directions

From Squirrel Hill: Take I-376 east (Parkway East) to Exit 80-Business Route 22, stay straight until you see Sam's Club on your left, after that light turn right at the first entrance to Monroeville Mall, bear right and proceed past the Best Buy store.

Turn right at the stop sign in the back of the mall just pass the Guitar Center, (James St. Ext.), and go up the hill out of the mall complex.

At the stop sign on the top of the hill, turn left onto James St. proceed to the 1st light at the 5-way intersection. DO NOT take the sharp right onto Monroeville Blvd. Take the second right onto Rosecrest Drive. Follow Rosecrest thru 2 stop signs, 200 yards after the second stop sign Rosecrest Drive turns sharply to the right, the Family Park entrance is on the left.

Who can participate?

JCC Member Appreciation Days are open to any JCC member or Splash Pass member. Members ages 17 and younger must be accompanied and supervised by an adult 21 and over.

Is there a fee to participate aside from my JCC membership?

Is alcohol permitted?

Alcohol is only permitted to be consumed evenings after 4 pm and weekends.

How will it work with J&R Day Camp using the facility at the same time?

Day camp will continue to operate as normal. Family Park is a 100-acre facility with an Olympic sized pool, so there is plenty of space for everyone.

Designated areas will be available for members at the pool, surrounding pool deck, and parking lot.

Members should follow standard procedures when entering Family Park. JCC security staff are always on-site monitoring the property. Access to Family Park is granted only by swiping a valid membership card or being admitted by a security guard.

If my child is at J&R Day Camp and I come during the camp day, will I be allowed to spend time with them?

Campers participate in scheduled activities throughout Family Park and remain with their designated groups during the day.

While parents, family members and friends are welcome to briefly say hello if they see a camper in a shared area (such as the pool), they may not stay with or remove a camper from their group.

In order to maintain the integrity of the camp experience, we ask that families do not intentionally seek out the attention of their campers, not to disrupt the daily routines of camp.

If a camper needs to be removed from their camp group, arrangements must be made in advance with the Day Camp Director, Assistant Director or Office Manager.

I have young children. Will they be able to use the baby pool?

The baby pool, also known as the “mushroom pool” will be open from 1-8 pm on Member Appreciation Days.

What happens when there is inclement weather?
